Cyanobacterial (blue-green algal) blooms and/or toxins have been identified in this lake water

Protect yourself and your pets:

- Do not swim or wade in areas where blooms are visible.
- Avoid contact with blooms in the water and on shore. Wash with clean water if contact occurs.

- Do not drink or cook with water from this lake.
- Do not eat whole fish and trimmings as fish may store toxins in their liver.
 Fish fillets contain less toxins and are safer to eat.
