For the larger items, such as grass mowing, there could be a weekly rate, and for items such as general clean-up an hourly rate.

- ~ mid May mid Sept (if additional weeks are required, a weekly rate is charged)
 - Picnic grounds, tennis court area, Smith park, boulevards, Itaska / Johnsonia pathway: Cut weekly mid May mid September
 - At the front of the Village Entrance cut weekly:
 - o Entrance ditch West to house #5 and house #1
 - o Entrance ditch East we cut for 65 yards to make our entrance look good
 - Ditches: Left to naturalize. If the edge of the ditch is out of control, a strip to be cut upon request at hourly rate; That we cut a regular push mower strip along the Audubon side of the ditch to keep the poplar and grass roots from encroaching and breaking up the road bed. This would go right around the turnaround area as well.
 - Turn around area: a one metre cut along the edge of the gravel only, with remainder to be naturalized
 - Cut boat launch four (4) times
 - Trim drainage ditch near #31B
 - Cut around base of signs in Summer Village, Audobon and Itaska to Jonsonia road once in fall
 - Do not cut close to the creeks on either side of the road (ie. Near #55)
 - Weed eat the daisies from both sides of the ditches as these are an invasive species.
 - Wiper sniping of poplar trees and noxious weeds; completed as required approximately monthly.

Level of grass: Please cut at 2 ½ inches

Flower / Shrub Beds & Playground

- Smith Park, Entrance Signs: weed, water, prune & maintain the beds ~ 4 times
- Weed the playground, tennis court, volleyball court and basketball court areas
- Blow out playground in spring for leaves and debris hourly rate
- Rake and clean the sand areas hourly rate

Garbage Cans

Move the residential garbage cans back to property in the winter months bi-weekly from November – April.

Leaf Pick-Up

• Two leaf pick-ups each year in the spring (after the May long week-end) and fall (after Thanksgiving). Residents will put clear bags at the end of their driveway for pickup.

Miscellaneous

- Pick up garbage as needed
- **Weed Inspector:** As per the Summer Village requirement to appoint a weed inspector to enforce and monitor compliance with the Alberta Weed Control Act.
